# TCC 2018's Highlights

## Objectives

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of the Tunisian Chemical Society Conference on Coordination Chemistry which aims at providing a forum for discussions of all aspects of coordination chemistry and to give an overview of the state of the art in this field. Young chemists are particularly encouraged to participate and they will find answers to questions that stimulate their continued research. Six subsections will focus on frontier topics of coordination chemistry, including recent results that would impact our daily life, such as development of new ligands for drug design, catalysts for modern plastics and functional nanomaterials. The meeting will help scientists to identify important applications of coordination compounds.

The conference will bring together not only coordination chemists but also organic and analytical chemists as well as scientists with academic (biology, medicine, physics) or industrial background to share scientific knowledge in an interdisciplinary atmosphere and to foster collaboration between these scientists. This will generate significant impact regarding future research in coordination chemistry on an international level.

## Topics

Topics of interest for submission include, but are not limited to:

1. Ligand Design in Organic Synthesis
2. Metals in Biology, Medicine and Materials
3. Metal Complexes: Structure and Reactivity
4. Catalysis, Environment
5. Energy and Sustainable Materials
6. Computations and Theory

## Program

The program of **JCC 2019** includes:

- invited lectures (35 minutes)
- oral communications (15 minutes) and posters
- an exhibition of scientific equipment

A booklet containing all the conference abstracts and papers will be distributed to participants. Authors are required to provide a summary of an **A5 page** in MS-Word format according to the following instructions:

- Superior margin of 2.5 cm, 2.2 cm margins on each side and a bottom margin of 1.5 cm. A template model is available for download in **JCC 2019 website**.
- Font typeface for the whole abstract: Times New Roman
- Title: 10, centered, bold, spacing 1
- Authors' names: 9, centered, spacing 1, with presenting author's name underlined
- Authors' affiliation: 8, centered, italic, spacing 1
- Text: 9, justified, spacing 1.

## Posters Presentation

Posters should be 1.20 m high and 0.90 m wide. Abstracts of posters will be numbered and listed in the final program. Different sessions will be held for poster presentations. Authors are requested to be next to their posters during the official poster sessions.
