# JCC2015's Highlights

# Objectives

This is the 1st edition of the Tunisian Chemical Society Conference on Coordination Chemistry which aims at providing a forum for discussions of all aspects of coordination chemistry and to give an overview of the state of the art in this field. Young chemists are particularly encouraged to participate and they will find answers to questions that stimulate their continued research. Five subsections will focus on frontier topics of coordination chemistry, including recent results that would impact our daily life, such as development of new ligands for drug design, catalysts for modern plastics and functional nanomaterials. - Authors' affiliation (centered, Arial 8, italic, spacing 1)
- Text (justified, Arial 9, spacing 1).

Posters should be 1.20 m high and 0.90 m wide. Abstracts of posters will be numbered and listed in the final program. Different sessions will be held for poster presentations. Authors are requested to be next to their posters during the official poster sessions.
